3	MAYOR McGINTY: Ma'am, sir, tell
4	us what it is you're interested in
5	doing.
6	MS. CLANCY: We purchased the
7	house together. I live upstairs with
8	my husband. I'm a teacher in Far
9	Rockaway. He's FDNY. My daughter
10	goes to Hegarty and my other younger
11	daughter goes to Sea Shells down the
12	street. And my parents are on the
13	first floor. And so we're just hoping
14	to live together there. This is where

7	further, please, Madam Clerk, pardon
8	me. This is specifically the auditors
9	would like Nicole Skalone, our
10	accountant, to be better trained.
11	This is I think they recommended
12	this accounting firm for the
13	accounting training. I think it's a
14	great idea and I think it's important.
15	Secondly, it's not going to be
16	the last time. We may I have to
17	speak to Farrow from the our court
18	vendor to make that our Deputy Clerk,
19	Melissa Mealy, her training is up to
20	speed or whether we need additional
21	training there. The next when we
22	get a chance for any type of building
23	or training, we're going to include
24	Rena Benson. I want to bring

I want to raise

everybody's training.

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2	everybody up so-to-speak.
3	And then Georusso, Mr. Georusso
4	from PBI is going to give additional
5	training on his own, no cost to the
6	Village, additional training to
7	Tammy Locastro.
8	TRUSTEE VOLPE-REID: Michael, how
9	much training? This is going to 2023.
10	I mean, what is the training, how
11	much, and what's the final cost going
12	to be?
13	MAYOR McGINTY: I don't know what
14	the final cost she's not going to
15	be training for three years. We
16	had
17	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: This is
18	putting this into a contract here. I
19	don't
20	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
21	Volpe-Ried, I did not know how long
22	the training would be, whether it was
23	continuing ed training. Because now
24	remember, we have an ongoing situation
25	with the financial accounting

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2	standpoint and the government county
3	standards. There's a constant change.
4	For example, we needed training to
5	Isolo for the
6	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: That's one
7	person.
8	MAYOR McGINTY: No, this
9	accounting the accounting is simply
10	for Skalone, for Nicole. She's the
11	only one getting accounting training.
12	But we've had a number of changes in
13	the statutory financial and accounting
14	reporting and she's hasn't got a clue.
15	It's not her fault. No one has, you
16	know
17	TRUSTEE VOLPE-REID: But then you
18	mentioned Tammy
19	MAYOR McGINTY: No, different
20	TRUSTEE VOLPE-REID: I don't
21	understand.
22	MAYOR McGINTY: Different
23	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Just I'm
24	asking for clarification.
25	MAYOR McGINTY: Okay. Different

2	situation. What I'm saying is that
3	this training is for Nicole. Farrow
4	from FSB what's Farrows Firm? Law
5	Enforcement LES, Law Enforcement
6	Service. Mr. Farrow, he'll be
7	training he does continuing ed
8	training for Melissa. We will do
9	we'll do additional training through
10	Georusso, the payroll company for
11	Tammy. Those two are going to be done
12	at no cost to the Village. Any
13	training we can get for Renabenson,
14	there may be a cost depending on who
15	provides it or maybe provides it
16	throughout the town of Hempstead
17	continuing education. The point I'm
18	trying to make is we need to keep our
19	staff up-to-date in the aftermath
20	that's all come before us.
21	Now, the three-year contract, I
22	don't know where it says it, but
23	Madam Clerk, do you remember? I
24	thought the accounting services were
25	for an hourly rate of do you

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2	remember the number?
3	MS. CONROY: The way that the
4	contract was prepared by CFM is a
5	monthly fee and
6	MAYOR McGINTY: Do you remember
7	the monthly fee?
8	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: It says it
9	right here, 11.50 per month effective
10	June then it says we'll increase to
11	1,200 commencing on June 1st, 2023.
12	So it's not
13	MAYOR McGINTY: Yeah, I don't see
14	it being with us that long.
15	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: That's not
16	what it says in the contract.
17	MS. CONROY: It says 30 days
18	notice for cancelation
19	MAYOR McGINTY: Termination.
20	MS CONROY: which is, you
21	know, something to keep in mind 'cause
22	I feel that Nicole has really learned
23	a lot and most certainly has a lot of
24	capability.
25	MAYOR McCINTY. I moan this is

1	
2	not a further contract.
3	MS. CONWAY: It's the resources
4	that we need now to support the
5	functioning of the office as suggested
6	by our accounting firm.
7	MAYOR McGINTY: Our Aloyed
8	(phonetic) firm.
9	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
10	All right. I read this as we're
11	signing a three-year contract. The
12	first year from now to June is going
13	to cost us the ninety-two hundred
14	dollars. I just figured it out on the
15	calculator. The next year is going to
16	cost us \$14,400.00 and the third year
17	will cost us 15
18	MAYOR McGINTY: Okay. Why don't
19	we table it and we can
20	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
21	Excuse me. Can I just finish my
22	thought?
23	MAYOR McGINTY: Sure.
24	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
25	That will come out to two and a half

1	
2	years that we start in October, not in
3	June of this year, it's \$39,200.00.
4	So I like the recommendation that we
5	do table this.
6	MAYOR McGINTY: That's fine.
7	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
8	Yes.
9	MAYOR McGINTY: All right. So we
10	have a Motion on the table to or we
11	have a Motion to table the proposed
12	accounting contract.
13	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So moved.
14	MAYOR McGINTY: Good.
15	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
16	Second.
17	MAYOR McGINTY: And role call,
18	please, for the table.

17	VHB is the consultant we're using
1.8	for the Transit Oriented Development
19	Project. I would like
20	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Long Beach
21	Road?
22	MAYOR McGINTY: Long Beach Road.
23	The Transit Oriented Development
24	Zoning Overlay, Zoning Overlay,
25	includes Long Beach Road, the parcel

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2	or parcels of land known as Pops
3	Restaurant, etcetera, and the Quebec
4	Road basin.
5	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
6	I have a question.
7	MAYOR McGINTY: Ask your
8	questions then.
9	DEPUTY MAYOR TRUSTEE ANNARELLA:
10	I'm not for giving somebody \$10,000.00
11	up front when there's companies that
12	go for grants, if they get you a
13	grant, they take a percentage. I'd
14	rather go with that then just give
15	someone 10,000 up front. So I'm not
16	in favor of this.
17	MAYOR McGINTY: Okay. Well,
18	that's fine. I'm going to make my
19	case. This is a specialized
20	situation. We use them for the
21	Transit Oriented Development Zoning

24	As far as in this particular
25	neche, there is not a grant company

2	out there that will work on a
3	percentage basis. And we're not
4	talking about we're talking about
5	grants in excessive of half a million
6	dollars. These are not like
7	five-thousand dollar grants or a
8	twenty-five thousand safer grant for
9	the Fire Department. This is a
10	different kettle of fish. Entirely
11	different. I think we're going to
12	need them going forward particularly
13	as it relates to any downtown work we
14	do here. For example, there was a
15	time in recent past where we used
16	community development funds to enhance
17	and restore businesses along Long
18	Beach Road. It just so happens the
19	businesses are on Long Beach Road.
20	That funding is no longer available.
21	However, there are funding
22	opportunities in other places. For
23	example, there was a grant program
24	that was just approved for the Town of
25	Hempstead after three attempts at it

3	Baldwin neighbor, the Grand Avenue
4	business district.
