7	Governor's Office of Storm Recovery is
8	administering the Fire House
9	Resiliency and Hardening Project which
10	will provide improvements and Flood
11	Mitigation Measures including the
12	addition of a One-Story Vehicle Bay to
13	the Fire House Building; and,
14	Whereas, the Village requested
15	relocation of the new elevator at the
16	Fire House Building; and,
17	Whereas, additional costs will be
18	incurred for relocation of the
19	elevator in addition to other costs
20	due to change orders, additions and
21	alteration;
22	Now therefore be it resolved, the
23	Mayor and Board of Trustees have
24	authorized the additional project
25	costs and have funding provided for

3	orders, additions, and alterations
4	associated with the project.
5	MAYOR McGINTY: One moment,
6	please. The only change order we
7	authorize relates to the elevator.
8	I'm not about to ask for a Motion
9	authorized change orders willy-nilly;
10	are we clear on that?
11	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: So why is it on
12	our Agenda tonight?
13	MAYOR McGINTY: I'm not going
14	to I'm not going to offer for
15	Motion to the calendar for a blanket
16	on change orders. As we speak now,
17	H2M, specifically Mr. Brennen are
18	reviewing requested change orders from
19	the contractors. They're under
20	review. We haven't okayed anything
21	except the elevator change.
22	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: All right. So
23	we need to change the wording on that,
24	Michael.
25	MAYOR McCINTY. I'm the quire

15	and that relates to the relocation of
16	the new elevator at the Fire House
17	Building, and only that change order.

9	MAYOR McGINTY: Madam Clerk, we
10	did Table and this is a new proposed
11	agreement, and it relates to the use
12	of the Craig, Fitzsimmons CPA firm on
13	an as needed basis for a specific
14	hourly rate.
15	Madam Clerk, what's the hourly
16	rate; do you remember?
17	MS. CONROY: It's he has a fee
18	schedule predicated upon the
19	professional capability of a staff
20	member.
21	MAYOR McGINTY: And the range of
22	that fee schedule, please?
23	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: It says
24	engagement partner 250, consulting
25	partner 230, CPA manager 185, senior

2	associate is 165, associate 150, and
3	administrative staff clerical 120.
4	New staff how much staff? I mean
5	this was not
6	MAYOR McGINTY: Remember, that's
7	on an as needed basis, prior approval
8	and depending on who we use and for
9	what purpose.
10	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So every
11	time we need them I just want
12	clarification. Every time we need
13	them, we call them; it's not going to
14	be as needed that we just decide and
15	they're just saying it's needed;
16	correct?
17	MAYOR McGINTY: Correct, we
18	contact them.
19	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Okay.
20	Because they never came to discuss
21	this with us.
22	Okay. Is that we're going to
23	contact them?
24	MAYOR McGINTY: That is correct.
25	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: And this is

2	the rate, engagement partner,
3	consulting partner, CPA manager. And
4	clerical just says 120.
5	How many how many clerical?
6	There's not
7	MAYOR McGINTY: No clerical.
8	It's administrative. But I can assure
9	you, we won't be using the
10	administrative. We will not use the
11	administrative. That's what we have
12	staff in the office for.
13	And Trustee Volpe-Ried, while
14	we're at it, we're going to ask or
15	well, we're going to direct, I
16	shouldn't say 'ask,' we are going to
17	direct staff to commit themselves to
18	New York State Comptroller classes as
19	they occur. And those classes are, if
20	they're not free-of-charge, they're de
21	minimis cost. The cost de minimis.
22	Minimal.
23	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I just
24	Mike, it says special we understand
25	the need for the Village change

<u>T</u>	
2	routinely. The need of additional
3	service outside of the scope of the
4	services outlined above, we'll meet
5	with the Board prior to commencement
6	to understand their needs a develop an
7	appropriate agreed upon fee structure
8	(indicating). The fee structure on
9	the top, that's not what it says here
10	(indicating). I'm just a little
11	I I I'm just confused. I'm
12	sorry, I don't want to be difficult,
13	but I don't understand why we never
14	had their meeting with us and
15	discussed this first.
16	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: So, Michael, I
17	think we should just Table it.
18	MAYOR McGINTY: May I speak,
19	please?
20	This the reason I didn't call
21	for a Meeting with them is these are
22	cut and dried accounting services, not
23	policy services. In other words, if
24	we were preparing reports for New York
25	State Comptroller or for the Federal

1.	
2	Government or the State Government, we
3	may in fact need their services.
4	As it relates directly to
5	accounting and treatment of certain
6	expenses and certain revenue, it's a
7	very, very limited scope.
8	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I just don't
9	want to find that we, all of the
10	sudden, are in engaged with them
11	and then we end up that we have to
12	you know, that they're doing
13	something, we have to pay them based
14	on what it says here (indicating).
15	You know, I'm just that's what I'm
16	questioning, Mike. That's all. I
17	just want like the special project,
18	what special projects? If something
19	arises and they decide it's a special
20	project.
21	MAYOR McGINTY: No, no, they
22	don't make any decisions on when
23	they're going to provide services to
24	us. Those decisions are one-sided.
25	They are our decisions. And they do

2	indicate that if special projects do
3	occur, they will meet with the Board
4	prior to engagement.
5	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Wait, it
6	says this fee structure does not
7	include special projects (indicating)
8	Then over here it says we should list
9	special projects assigned by the
10	Board. Then it says, and the relative
11	fee structure we typically provide
12	(indicating). So I'm just confused.
13	Like it seems to me if they decide
14	this fee structure is not the
15	correct is not a good structure to
16	go by, they're just going to up their
17	price. Once we're once we're in
18	this commitment with them, then what
19	do we do? That's all I'm just
20	asking that question.
21	MAYOR McGINTY: Okay. First
22	off
23	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Because it
24	says right here, this fee structure
25	does not include special projects

2	assigned by the Board of Trustees
3	(indicating). So if we say there's a
4	special project I'm just
5	questioning Mike, I'm really not
6	trying to be difficult. It says it
7	here in their paperwork (indicating).
8	MAYOR McGINTY: Okay, Barbara
9	MS. CONROY: Mayor, may I make a
10	comment?
11	If perhaps the Board at a future
12	date decides to use the services of
13	CFM for development of the Village
14	budget, then that would be a
15	standalone project outside of the
16	scope of the services that are quoted
17	on the pages that you're referring to
18	with the fee schedule, so CFM would
19	meet with the Board. If the Board nov
20	would like their assistance with
21	developing the Village Budget, and a
22	cost would be prepared perhaps a
23	lump-sum prices apposed to ours. So I
24	believe that's what their stating
25	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Right. And

2	that's the way I'm reading it too.
3	So I'm just questioning that
4	because I
5	MAYOR McGINTY: Well, and I come
6	back to what I said before, according
7	to well, if we were to if we
8	were to hire them for a special
9	project, we would come together, meet
10	with them and make a decision at that
11	point. But otherwise, frankly, we're
12	going to utilize them for accounting
13	services that our staff that rises
14	above staff capability.
15	I can't hear anybody speaking.
16	Can I answer any other questions
17	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I think at this
18	point with all the questions, Michael
19	I think we should Table it.
20	MAYOR McGINTY: You know what,
21	why don't you draft your own
22	agreement. This is a this is a
23	simple, a simple hourly agreement if
24	the codicil that if any additional
25	projects come about and meet with the

2	Board and we make a decision on
3	whether or not we want and how much
4	we're going to pay them. I can't make
5	it any clearer than that.
6	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Okay. Can
7	we make sure that if we don't want
8	them, we're going to be put into this
9	thing like oh, you've been working for
10	us for this much
11	MAYOR McGINTY: No
12	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Now you
13	have to do that.
14	MAYOR McGINTY: No
15	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Because
16	that I mean this is why I find that
17	we can
18	MAYOR McGINTY: No, we would not
19	permit such a thing to happen. We
20	would not permit such a thing to
21	happen. Just as with the Fire House
22	Project and last Resolution, we were
23	very specific on the change order. We
24	didn't we didn't sign onto an omne
25	for a change order Resolution. We

2	wouldn't do that with any business
3	any Village business.
4	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Okay.
5	'Cause I'm just saying, if that's
6	because here it's like when I do this,
7	professional staff is a thousand
8	dollars an hour. If all the sudden
9	they come up and say look, you need us
10	to do this project, it's now going to
11	be ten thousand an hour, now we're
12	stuck with them.
13	MAYOR McGINTY: We are not stuck
14	with them.
15	For example, Capital Planning is
16	done specifically with McGinty and
17	Tanner and then brought to the Board.
18	Annual Audit Support, we do Annual
19	Audit Support with our auditors.
20	Budget Planning, we wouldn't have any
21	use for them in these three areas.
22	So, but no, no, it's an hourly it's
23	not an amoniquis consulting agreement,
24	nor would I permit it to be.
25	What is the Board's questions?

3	way that they can write that in there
4	that says that they're not we're
5	not committed to them?
6	MAYOR McGINTY: Barbara, Barbara,
7	why don't we Table this and you can
8	take the agreement seriously, you
9	take the agreement and make the
10	changes you want. I can't make it any
11	plainer than I am.
12	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: It's not a
13	change. This one part right here
14	(indicating). Can we take this out
15	where it says this fee structure does
16	not include special projects
17	(indicating)? I have a problem with
18	that because that's not that's
19	showing a thousand dollars an hour
20	this way. If all the sudden they
21	say and I I don't know, it
22	doesn't say that this is not they
23	could charge us 10 to 20 thousand
24	dollars an hour.
