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2	MAYOR McGINTY: Irene, there is
3	no one in attendance except for
4	Jean McGinty, Trustee Gagliardi,
5	Trustee Volpe-Ried and yours truly.
6	Amanda is here. Cassie's here she
7	said she wants to opt out. But
8	nobody's here from the Public.
9	Now, what I want to do, and I
10	didn't think about this until this
11	afternoon, I was at the Hearing at the
12	Town of Hempstead where they opted out
13	of the Marijuana law so-to-speak. I
14	want to call the Town and obtain that
15	portion of the Town Board Meetings
16	that relates directly to testimony for
17	the opt out law well, for either
18	way, the testimony for the marijuana
19	Hearing so-to-speak.
20	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Michael, can I
21	ask you a question about that?
22	MAYOR McGINTY: Yes.
23	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Just because I'm
24	not educated on it. How much money
25	would the Village get if we opted in?

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2	MAYOR McGINTY: There has been no
3	declarative or estimated revenue
4	number as we speak now.
5	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Okay.
6	MAYOR McGINTY: There's been no
7	number for the Towns, Cities, State.
8	But permit me to remind you of this,
9	the Local and Town and County lawsuits
10	related to the Pharma Industry and
11	specifically Fentanyl and OxyContin
12	were thrown well, New York State
13	took over those lawsuits and through
14	New York State law supported by the
15	New York State Senate, New York State
16	Assembly and Simon's Law by the
17	Government negated all of the Local
18	lawsuits as it relates to OxyContin,
19	Fentanyl and any of those narcotics
20	produced by the pharmaceutical
21	industry.
22	So if I may, not knowing, but if
23	I may, I really I really don't
24	think we'll ever see a dime.
25	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Okay.



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2	MAYOR McGINTY: Obviously we'll
3	keep track of it and obviously if
4	we're due funds, we're due funds, but
5	I don't see it to tell you the truth.
6	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: No, I agree with
7	this decision, Michael. I do. But
8	MAYOR McGINTY: I appreciate
9	that.
10	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: there are
11	people that are questioning that we
12	need money in the Village and why
13	won't we take this. And I just wanted
14	to be more educated on it. That's it.
15	MAYOR McGINTY: I appreciate
16	that.
17	Anyway, I want to get I want
18	to obtain the Transcript from
19	Tuesday's Hearing at Town Hall. The
20	Town of Hempstead Hearing on the opt
21	out law.
22	So for tonight we do not have a
23	Clerk, so I'll be reading to you.
24	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: You have to
25	read the whole thing?

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2	MAYOR McGINTY: Well, let me
3	start with the Public Hearing.
4	I would like a Motion to open the
5	Public Hearing and we'll go with Role
6	Call, please.
7	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I'll make it.
8	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee
9	Gagliardi.
10	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I'll second.
11	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
12	Naudus.
13	On the Motion.
14	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.
15	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I.
16	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Naudus.
17	MAYOR McGINTY: I.
18	All right. So this is a Public
19	Hearing to consider the Adoption of
20	Local Law 5 of the year 2021 entitled
21	Cannibis.
22	The purpose of this proposed
23	Local Law is to opt out of hosting and
24	prohibit the licensing and
25	establishment of retail cannabis

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2	dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis
3	consumption establishments within the
4	Village of Island Park pursuant to
5	Cannabis Law 131.
6	I don't see any residents and I
7	don't see any residents on Zoom. If
8	there's someone who wants to speak
9	we're in Village Hall and we're on
10	Zoom.
11	Is there anyone who wishes to
12	speak on this Hearing, at this
13	Hearing.
14	(Whereupon, there was no verbal
15	response.)
16	MAYOR McGINTY: Seeing none, I
17	would seek a Motion to close.
18	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So moved.
19	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee
20	Volpe-Ried.
21	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
22	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
23	Naudus.
24	MAYOR McGINTY: On the Motion.
25	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.

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2	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I.
3	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
4	MAYOR McGINTY: Unanimous. Good.
5	I would now seek a motion to
6	incorporate the Mayor's Report and the
7	Trustee's Report as part of the
8	transcript.
9	Motion, please.
10	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So moved.
11	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee
12	Volpe-Ried.
13	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
14	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
15	Naudus.
16	To make Reports part of the
17	Transcript. I wrote that out. I'm
18	writing it out because I made an
19	arrangement with our Deputy Clerk to
20	hand her my notes from tonight so that
21	she could incorporate them into the
22	official transcript, which means
23	please, during the month, you know,
24	prior to the next meeting
25	everybody well, somebody at least,

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2	check and see that I have not
3	misspoke, mislabeled, or made any
4	errors in my compellation for the
5	transcript. Thank you.
6	The first Resolution before us is
7	the Abstract of Audited Vouchers.
8	Now, we all have the Audited
9	Vouchers except I'm not sure
10	everyone has the last two. The last
11	two Vouchers are Vouchers to pay we
12	do have them. We have Vouchers for
13	Intertech (sic) and Sky Rise. They're
14	the people who are working at the
15	Firehouse.
16	And as what we have to know
17	is, pardon me, we move the money out
18	of the Village in an accelerated
19	fashion upon State audit and State
20	review. We then receive the money
21	back shortly within days. It's all
22	done electronically. But it's got to
23	come from us to the contractors and
24	back.
25	And now, you should also know

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2	that in the case of Sky Rise, their
3	remittences go directly to the
4	bounding company. The bounding
5	company has an arrangement, Sky Rise,
6	whereas they handle cash flow for Sky
7	Rise. Sky Rise is the general
8	contractor. So I don't know who knew
9	what but now you've got the whole
10	story.
11	So on the Abstract of Audited
12	Vouchers, do I have a Motion to put
13	the Abstract on the Calendar?
14	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So moved.
15	MAYOR McGINTY: Moved by Trustee
16	Volpe-Ried.
17	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
18	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
19	Naudus.
20	On the Motion, Trustee Gagliardi.
21	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: On the motion
22	for the Abstracts I.
23	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
24	Volpe-Ried.
25	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.

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2	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee Naudus.
3	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
4	MAYOR McGINTY: I vote I.
5	The Resolution duly adopted.
6	The second I'm going to be
7	redundant, the Board Meeting Minutes,
8	I would appreciate that the Board
9	Meeting this evening's Board
10	Meeting Minutes are reviewed by
11	Members of the Board prior to next
12	Meeting. I want to be sure that I
13	have not made an error. And if I do
14	I want it corrected ahead of time.
15	All right. So a Resolution to
16	except the Board Meeting Minutes.
17	Resolved, all the Board Meeting
18	Minutes recorded from November 24th,
19	2021 to December 8th, 2020 stand as
20	written without any corrections,
21	additions, or deletions.
22	Motion, please.
23	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I'll make the
24	Motion, Michael.
25	Motion by Trustee Naudus.

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2	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Second.
3	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
4	Volpe-Ried.
5	On the Motion, Trustee Gagliardi.
6	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I.
7	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
8	Volpe-Ried.
9	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.
10	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee Naudus.
11	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
12	MAYOR McGINTY: I vote I.
13	All right. We closed the Hearing
14	on the Local Law. Now we're going
15	to well, here we're going to adopt
16	Local Law 5 2021 Cannibis.
17	Opting Out Of Licensing And
18	Establishing Retail Cannabis
19	Dispensaries And On-Site Cannabis
20	Consumption Establishments Within The
21	Village Of Island Park Pursuant to
22	Cannabis Law 131.
23	Motion, please.
24	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I'll make it.
25	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee

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2	Trustee Gagliardi.
3	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
4	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
5	Naudus.
6	On the Motion, Trustee Gagliardi.
7	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I.
8	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
9	Volpe-Ried.
10	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.
11	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee Naudus.
12	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
13	MAYOR McGINTY: I vote I.
14	Now before we go to the next,
15	please keep in mind that the purpose
16	of opting out tonight was because
17	it fits in the timeline should someone
18	appear with 100 signatures and a valid
19	petition for a referendum. I don't
20	want to pay for two election days, so
21	if there is a referendum it would be
22	on the March election day. Do I think
23	we'll see one? I highly doubt it, but
24	I wanted to air on the side of
25	caution, and I don't know want to

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2	spend money that we don't have to
3	spend.
4	So the Resolution was declared
5	dully adopted. And for the record,
6	the Local Law will be remitted to the
7	Secretary of State Secretary of
8	State, New York.
9	The next Resolution, Village
10	Registration Day.
11	Resolved, that in accordance with
12	Section 15-118(3) of the Election Law
13	of the State of New York, there will
14	not be a Village registration day.
15	Motion.
16	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: So moved.
17	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee
18	Volpe-Ried.
19	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
20	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
21	Naudus.
22	On the Motion, Trustee Gagliardi.
23	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I.
24	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
25	Volpe-Ried.

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2	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: 1.
3	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee Naudus.
4	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
5	MAYOR McGINTY: I vote I.
6	The Resolution is declared dully
7	adopted.
8	The Fire Alarm System Upgrade.
9	Before we go into this, we had
10	two choices, a repair of 7,500 or an
11	entire new system at 25,000 and
12	change. The old system predated our
13	occupation of Village Hall.
14	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: And who was
15	it was antiquated.
16	MAYOR McGINTY: Right, it was
17	antiquated.
18	So I opted to suggest to the
19	Board that we go with the new system.
20	Resolved, the Mayor is authorized
21	to contract Johnson Controls for one
22	for one swap, main panel upgraded to a
23	4007es hybrid, current system is an
24	addressable system and it will remain
25	the same with simplex devices, for the

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2	cost of twenty-five thousand two
3	hundred forty-eight dollars and
4	seventy cents (\$25,248.70.)
5	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I'll make it.
6	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by Trustee
7	Gagliardi.
8	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Second.
9	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by Trustee
10	Volpe-Ried.
11	On the Motion, Trustee Gagliardi.
12	TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: On the motion
13	I.
14	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee
15	Volpe-Ried.
16	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: I.
17	MAYOR McGINTY: Trustee Naudus.
18	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: I.
19	MAYOR McGINTY: I vote I.
20	The Meeting is open to the
21	Public.
22	Seeing none I don't see I
23	have nobody on Zoom.
24	Jean McGinty is here with Cassie.
25	TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Well happy

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2	holidays to everyone.
3	MAYOR McGINTY: Happy holidays.
4	Merry Christmas. We'll talk to you
5	all soon. Thank you.
