SANITATION RULES

Garbage must be kept in pails with covers and should only be placed at the curb after 7:00 pm the evening prior to your scheduled pickup. Garbage should not be in the street or blocking sidewalks. Dumping any garbage or liquid in storm drains is strictly prohibited. All hazardous waste & medical waste, including sharps of any kind are strictly prohibited.

SPECIAL PICK UP:

MUST BE CALLED IN TO SCHEDULE FOR COLLECTION

All mattresses will be picked up Monday's only and must be placed into a bed bug proof bag prior to collection. There will be no exceptions.

RECYCLING

The following items are acceptable for recycling:

Plastic #1 & #2 Water and Soda Bottles Milk and Juice Bottles
Aluminum and Tin Cans Glass Bottles

All other products, including cardboard and plastic bags WILL NOT be accepted and should be considered garbage.

Recyclables must be in recycle bins.

Recyclables placed in plastic bags will not be picked up.

SNOW REMOVAL

Snow must be removed from sidewalks and walkways within 24hrs of snowfall.
Businesses must remove snow within 12hrs.

DO NOT SHOVEL OR BLOW SNOW INTO STREETS.
