7	Pledge of Allegiance, the meeting was
8	called to order.)
9	VILLAGE CLERK: Roll call.
10	TRUSTEE TICE: Sure.
11	MAYOR McGINTY: Please.
12	VILLAGE CLERK: Deputy Graci,
13	absent. Trustee Tice.
14	TRUSTEE TICE: Here.
15	VILLAGE CLERK: Trustee Naudus,
16	absent. Trustee Ried.
17	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Here.
18	VILLAGE CLERK: Mayor.
19	MAYOR McGINTY: Yes, ma'am.
20	VILLAGE CLERK: We have a
21	Public Hearing to consider the
22	adoption of Local Law 2 of the year
23	2023. A local law entitled revising
24	Local Law 23 of 2016, and Local Law 5
25	of 2017 Section 51-G-22 Penalties for



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2	offences is Amended as follows:
3	It shall be unlawful for any
4	person, firm or corporation to
5	construct, alter, repair, move,
6	remove, demolish, equip, use, occupy
7	or maintain any building or structure
8	or portion thereof in violation of
9	any provision of law or rule
10	promulgated by the Building
11	Department in accordance with
12	applicable laws or to fail, in any
13	manner to comply with a notice,
14	directive or order of the Building
15	Inspector or to construct, alter, use
16	or occupy-any building or structure
17	or part thereof in a manner not
18	permitted by an approved building or
19	plumbing permit of certificate of
20	occupancy.
21	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion to open
22	the Hearing.
23	TRUSTEE TICE: I will make it.
24	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion by
25	Trustee Tice.



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2	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Second.
3	MAYOR McGINTY: Second by
4	Trustee Ried. On the motion. Aye.
5	I guess, the first thing is, do
6	any of us have any comments? Does
7	the Board have any comments to make
8	about this proposal of the law?
9	TRUSTEE TICE: I have no
10	comment.
11	TRUSTEE VOLPE-RIED: Nope.
12	MAYOR McGINTY: Seeing none.
13	For the record, we have one attendee
14	this evening, Jeanne McGinty. This
15	deals with zombie housing. And at
16	the risk of being politically
17	incorrect, we are tired of it. We
18	are tired of 57 Radcliffe Road. I
19	don't care that it's on the record.
20	It's true. We are tired of it. We
21	are tired of some of the others,
22	including what is the name of that
23	place? The restaurant, the Red Choo
24	Choo? We are not a dumping ground
25	for anybody or anything.



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2	So we are joined by one of the
3	Commissioners from the Barnum Fire
4	District, the Honorable Frank
5	Bettineschi.
6	MR. BETTINESCHI: How are you
7	today?
8	MAYOR McGINTY: Good, sir. We
9	have opened the floor to a Hearing.
10	We are going to raise fines and so
11	forth and punishments for people who
12	zombie properties and they are not
13	taking care of it at our expense. Do
14	you have anything to say?
15	MR. BETTINESCHI: No.
16	MAYOR McGINTY: Motion to
17	close. Do you have anything?
18	MRS. McGINTY: No. I agree.
19	MAYOR McGINTY: And wait a
20	second. This doesn't mean that I
21	have to cut the grass every week,

10	corner of Pershing and Island
11	Parkway, as you are going toward
12	Harbor Isle, as you go toward Harbor
13	Isle, there is a stop sign. We
